School Dress Code

Our modified school uniform policy is better described as a school apparel program. Under this definition, students will be allowed to select various BDCHS shirts, which reflect individual style and comfort. All school shirts must be purchased at school, on the website, or at Image Depot located at 2017 East Fowler Avenue • Tampa, FL 33612

Each student will be required to have **2 mandatory uniform shirts**: one polo and one oxford. Each grade level will have a color specific crest embroidered polo shirt, and 1 oxford cloth shirt. The ninth grade polo shirts will be burgundy. Tenth graders will wear gold polo shirts, eleventh grade will have white polo shirts, and twelfth grade will have green polo shirts. Mandatory shirts must be worn to grade specific events, picture day and whenever directed by the school administration.

Students may purchase other color polo shirts, but only in the BDCHS logo style. All other BDCHS apparel is considered fashion shirts and can be worn to school within the uniform policy. All school shirts must be worn within the following dress policy.

Bottoms may include long pants, Capri pants, knee-length shorts, skorts and skirts. Shorts, skorts, and skirts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Uniform bottom color is khaki. Fabric should be Dockers®-style or dress fabric.

Shoes must be solid (one color) black. Multicolor athletic shoes are NOT permitted. Flip-flop/beach/water/shower shoes are NOT permitted.

Oversized clothes are NOT permitted. All bottoms must be belted and/or properly fitted at the waist. NO SAGGING ALLOWED.

Jeans will ONLY be permitted on days designated by the administration.

Students who demonstrate poor moral/ethical character while wearing school apparel in public settings, will be severely disciplined and/or dismissed from BDCHS.

Dress Policy Violations

- 1st offense ~ Student will be removed from class; parent/guardian will be notified and given the option to pick up student or bring appropriate apparel.
- 2nd offense ~ same as 1st offense plus 3 days work detail during lunch (15 minute lunch / 15 minute detail)
- 3rd offense ~ same as 2nd offense plus two 4 hour Saturday work details (failure to attend becomes automatic 3 day Out-of-School Suspension (OSS))
- 4th offense ~ Parent pick up and 3 day Out-of-School Suspension (OSS)
- 5th offense ~ Student recommended for dismissal from BDCHS
