



BDCHS Athletics Eligibility Checklist

In order to be eligible for the *privilege* of interscholastic competition, a scholar-athlete must complete the following materials and turn it into Coach Melton prior to beginning practice with their first sport of the academic year.

ALL STUDENTS:

- Physical Evaluation – FHSAA Form EL2**
 - Must be completed by licensed physician, licensed osteopathic physician, licensed chiropractic physician, licensed physician assistant or certified advanced registered nurse practitioner.
 - Requires signatures of physician, student’s guardian and student
- Parent Consent – FHSAA Form EL3**
 - Must be signed by student’s guardian and student
 - Part 2.E. is checked for you. School provides insurance for all students involved in interscholastic athletics. Should you wish to provide your own personal insurance information, that is fine.
 - Part 2.A. Student’s guardian must CIRCLE sports that student is permitted to play. We offer Girls Volleyball, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball and Baseball.

- Athletic Recruiting Compliance – FHSAA Form GA4**
 - This form attempts to ensure that new students to the school have not been athletically recruited. Please read carefully.
 - Requires signatures of student guardian, student and **NOTARY PUBLIC**.
